- Conducting data gap analyses, reviewing data packages, developing regulatory and testing strategies, and designing and monitoring studies;
- Interpreting and summarising data from scientific studies and literature, forming argumentation and advocacy positions;
- Managing projects and direct delivery of relevant dossier sections, in support of active substance and product registrations in Europe.

Candidates should ideally have a proven ability serving private sector clients and interfacing with government agencies. The successful candidate will provide regulatory assistance to registrants seeking to comply, in particular, with EU and UK registration requirements. The position requires close interaction with registration specialists and technical support staff at CSI's offices in Europe and North America.

Key qualities for a successful candidate include initiative, the ability to work well in a "virtual" team environment, and a positive customer focus. Computer literacy and good verbal and written communication skills are essential. Some travel will be required.
